It is our pleasure to invite you to participate in the 15th International conference “*General and Specialist Translation/Interpretation: Theory, Methods, Practice*”, which will be held on April 20-21, 2023 at the National Aviation University, Faculty of Linguistics and Social Communications, Department of English Philology and Translation/Interpretation (Kyiv, Ukraine).

Academics, researchers, graduate and postgraduate students, translators/interpreters are invited to participate in the conference.

The topic of the conference covers various aspects of the theory and practice of translation/interpretation, training of translation specialists.

Conference languages: Ukrainian, English, Polish.

Conference format: ONLINE videoconference.

The Conference embraces the following broad topic areas:

1. Specialist translation/interpretation. Terminology in translation/interpretation perspective.
2. Sociocultural and pragmatic aspects of translation/interpretation.
3. Lexical, grammatical and stylistic aspects of translation/interpretation.
4. Translation tradition and translation theory.
5. Professional training of translators/interpreters.
6. ICT in translators' work.

The papers of the conference participants will be published in the International Conference Papers, which will be placed on the website of the Department of English Philology and Translation and sent together with the conference program and the certificate of participation (12 hours, 0.4 ECTS credits in PDF format) to the email address specified in the application form (within 3-5 days).

International Conference Papers are a scientific publication, recommended by the Academic Council of the Faculty of Linguistics and Social Communications indexed by ISBN.

Terms of participation in the conference

For the participation in the Conference, please, submit to the e-mail of the conference the following items till **April 04, 2023**:

- **application form** (please, see the attached application form);
- **paper** in the form of a computer file, saved in rtf format, formatted according to the requirements below;
- **for students, who submit their papers solely** – a scanned copy (photo) of the scientific supervisor's **recommendation** (a short recommendation of up to 10 lines is enough, which indicates that the supervisor has read the content of the paper/research and believes that its content and format correspond to the level, topics and requirements of the conference).
- When the receipt of the paper is confirmed by the Organizing Committee, the participant pays the participation fee of 200 UAH and sends a scanned copy of the receipt to the conference e-mail address: afp@npp.nau.edu.ua

PART OF THE CONFERENCE FEES WILL BE DIRECTED TO THE ARMED FORCES OF UKRAINE

Full Professors and those with Doctoral degrees are exempt from the publication fees!

Requirements to the papers:

1. Length (summary and key words inclusive): 10,000-15,000 characters without spaces. Summary and key words should be **in English** (not more than 700 characters without spaces).
2. Standard: Word format; font type – TimesNewRoman; font size – 10; line spacing – 1; paragraph indentation – 0,53 cm; margins – 2 cm; pages shouldn't be numbered; please, distinguish between hyphen and dash symbols, Ukrainian («») and Latin ("") brackets. Please, unify the use of the bold type and italics in the examples and text paragraphs and do not make use of excessive highlighting.
3. 1-st line, align right: First, Last Name of the author (**bold italics**); 2-nd line, align right: city, country (*italics*).
4. Skip line 3, line 4 – the title of the paper (center aligned, **bold type**).
5. Skip line 5, line 6 – summary and key words in English, followed by the paper itself.

6. References in the text should be made in square brackets: [2, p. 34]. The number of the title in the References and the page of the reference are marked by a comma, followed by a space, the number of the title in the References – by a semicolon, for example: [6; 7; 8], [8, p. 21; 9, p. 117]. We put a full stop **after** brackets, citations.

7. References are placed at the end of the paper under the heading **Literature or References** (center aligned). In the References the titles should be given the order they appear in the text under DSTU 8302:2015. **It is mandatory** to specify the city of the publication, name of the publishing house, year, total number of pages (not applied to Internet sources).

8. Please, save your file in the rtf format.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to carry out scientific and literary editing of the received materials or send the paper to the author for revision. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject papers that do not meet the specified requirements or that were received *after April 4, 2023*. After receiving the paper, the Organizing Committee will notify you by e-mail within 1-2 days of its receipt. Should you fail to receive such a confirmation we advise you to check with the Organizing Committee by e-mail to make sure that your paper has been received and accepted for publication.
